GLASS CONTAINERS PROHIBITED IN PARK

6-2-1: Glass Containers Within Park, Prohibited

It is unlawful for any person to possess any glass container within the confines of the Town park of Westcliffe, Colorado described as:

All of Block 15 and all of Powell Street between Third and Fourth Streets, Town of Westcliffe.

6-2-2: Exception to Prohibition

Upon request the Board of Trustees may allow possession of glass containers within said park in association with special events. Application for said possession must be made and approved prior to said possession. (Ord. 11-1985, 10-15-1985)

6-2-3: Penalties

Any person violating this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall upon conviction thereof, be fined a sum not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or be committed to serve a term of not more than 90 days in jail or both. (Ord. 11-1985, 10-15-1985)

6-2-4: Confiscation

In the event any police officer of the Town of Westcliffe shall find, detect or discover any glass container within the confines of said park, he or she may immediately confiscate said container. (Ord. 11-1985, 10-15-1985)
